Working at Franklin provides a very stimulating environment for innovative teaching and resource development. As a rapidly growing college and the designated sixth form provider for the North East Lincolnshire area we are always looking for ways to improve the delivery of our wide and varied curriculum. The Genee Vision has had a dramatic impact in the quality of the drawing it inspires in my students, a couple of my students who have gone to university interviews have been told that their work was approaching Degree standard.

The main difference to teaching this way is that on a whiteboard/smartboard/blackboard, what you are drawing is not in the same medium as the student, meaning they may be drawing in pen/ marker whereas you the teacher are using whiteboard pen/smart board pen – their results don't look the same as yours even if they are getting it right. With a visualiser they can see if they are 'getting it' – the feedback is more instant.

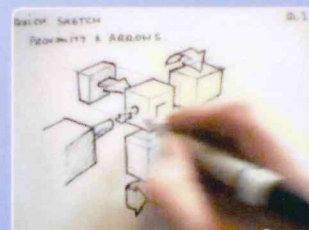
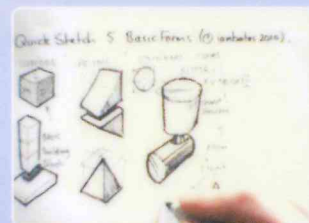
