The project

A roleplay project using special effects to create drama and tension.

Key objectives/outcomes

The children will understand how to present themselves to an audience, will understand how and why special effects are used and they will create their own short drama which will be edited.

Actions taken

- The children will become familiar with the functions on the visualiser (zoom, negative, flip etc.)
- The children will watch and read various short plays.
- The children will write their own short play script including stage directions and notes on special effects to be used.
- The children will perform and record their plays, recording them on the visualiser.
- Children will edit their recorded plays using the software.
